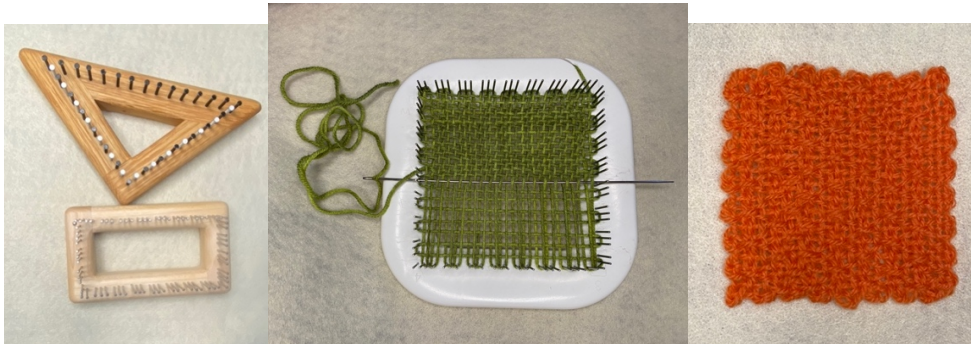




**Pin Loom Weaving**  
**Friday, May 8 from 10 AM – 1 PM at PNNAG OFFICE**

Come learn the basics of pin loom weaving! Learn how to warp and weave a 4-inch pin loom that has “sets” of 3 pins, how to take a square off the loom, and practice one or two joining stitches. You’ll create squares with one color, with two colors, and one with a textured pattern. There will be a demonstration of continuous strand weaving. Many woven samples and pin looms styles/sizes will be on hand to view. Woven pieces also make wonderful blank slates to embellish further with cross-stitch, embroidery, and/or beads.

All supplies/handouts provided – you can also bring your own pin loom/supplies to use.

Marion enjoys weaving on small looms, is working on her tapestry and rigid heddle weaving skills and is active in local fiber arts and sewing guilds.
