Create gorgeous Psanky Eggs just in time for Easter! The method is similar to batik - patterns are drawn on the egg with wax, which then protects the covered areas from the dye that is applied. Play with 12 luminous rich dye colors and let your inner artist shine – design options are unlimited. You'll receive 4 prepared eggs to work with and can bring additional eggs to dye as well. Join us for a most egg-cellent time!
